Statement on the Mission	of the Church	Elder, Adele Trout		

One: The mission of God in Christ gives shape and substance to the life and work of the church. Today, we reclaim our historic calling and remember the Great Ends of the church:

ALL: The proclamation of the Gospel for the salvation of humankind; the shelter, nurture and spiritual fellowship of the children of God; the maintenance of divine worship; the preservation of truth; the promotion of social righteousness; and the exhibition of the Kingdom of Heaven to the world.

One: The ministry of the church is shared by pastor and people... Therefore, the New Castle Presbytery, by means of the commission, now installs Eddie Jusino as Pastor of Westminster Presbyterian Church. In his baptism, Eddie was clothed with Christ. He was ordained as a teaching elder by The Presbytery of the Pacific and is now called by God through the voice of the church to serve as pastor of this congregation.

ALL: We remember with joy our common calling to serve Christ, and we celebrate God's call to our brother, to serve among us as pastor.

Will you in your own life seek to follow the Lord Jesus Christ, love your neighbors, and work for the reconciliation of the world? **Response: I will.** Do you promise to further the peace, unity and purity of the church? **Response: I do.**

Will you pray for and seek to serve the people with energy, intelligence, imagination, and love? **Response: I will.**

Will you be a faithful minister of the Word and Sacrament, proclaiming the good news in Word and Sacrament, teaching faith, and caring for people? Will you be active in government and discipline, serving in the councils of the church; and in your ministry, will you try to show the love and justice of Jesus Christ? **Response: I will.**
